**Today's Guest Preacher:** Pastor Adrian Jacobs is a Cayuga First Nation member of the Six Nations Haudenosaunee Confederacy of the Grand River Territory, Ont.

Jacobs has been involved in spiritual and social service training for Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples in various places in the United States and Canada. He formerly served as Keeper of the Circle/Principal of Sandy-Saulteaux Spiritual Centre, an Indigenous ministry training school for the United Church of Canada, located in Beausejour, Man.

"Adrian is an Elder and founding member of the Board of NAIITS—An Indigenous Learning Community and a frequent leader and contributor to evangelical and ecumenical dialogue on Indigenous justice and rights," added Mike Hogeterp, former director of the CRC's Centre for Public Dialogue.

Currently, Adrian is Senior Leader for Indigenous Justice and Reconciliation working out of the CRCNA Burlington office.
